

How Collaboration Works

If two classes would like to work together, Kidscapism carefully makes that process possible.

Pupils in different classes might want to:

Email each other...
Swap stories of life in the other class...
Collaborate in writing stories together...
Share topic work...

Here is how it works:

1. You, as one of our registered teachers (contacted by us to ensure they are a teacher at their school) have set up a class at their school, and populated it with students.
2. You browse our list of collaborating schools.
3. You indicate (on the 'Edit' tab of your own class) that you would like to collaborate with another school. You write a very short description of the kind of collaboration you are looking for.
4. This class gets added to our listings of schools who would like to collaborate .
5. You then select a class from the list which you would like to consider collaborating with.
6. You click on 'Link'
7. You are taken to a confirmation page with further information
8. You click on 'Link up with Teacher X'
9. A box lets you elaborate on the reasons and objectives for the potential collaboration. This message is sent to the other teacher.
10. The other teacher can then accept or reject the link (and can again elaborate on why – if they wish).
11. If the link is accepted, a new class is created called 'Teacher X and Teacher Ys Linked Class'.
12. The new class is initially empty, but both teachers can then add students to the class.
13. The new class will show up as normal on your teachers page.
